### Old Business

1. The minutes of 8/20/07 were approved as amended.

2. Updates:

a. The Storm Water Study Report. This outline of this study report was presented to the Board on September 16, 2006 by Gene Kudgus. This report will be an update on the drainage problem-areas depicted on the Public Works map of Oak Island, topographical drawings of each problem area to identify both where pooling occurs and potential solutions, and the funding necessary to correct problem areas (both equipment and personnel). Mr. Kudgus updated the Board on May 21, 2007 stating that the work done by Jim Musselwhite was good and only in need of some edits.

Mr. Michaux had no update on this and will request one from Mr. Kudgus to be given to the Board at its October meeting.

b. Storm Water Management Plan. Mr. Michaux gave this update on our progress toward compliance with Phase 1 of the NPDES permit.

1. EnviroScape purchase has been approved and the middle school science teacher has agreed to present it to his 8<sup>th</sup> grade students this academic year.

2. The Brunswick County Extension Director will do a rain garden presentation on Feb 21<sup>st</sup>. Mr. Kudgus and Michaux are looking for sites on town property to do a demonstration rain garden.
3. Barrels are available at no cost from Mount Olive Pickle Company and can be retrofitted to be rain barrels. A rain barrel workshop will also be planned and Lowe's Home Improvement will be approached to donate the retrofitting equipment for 25 barrels.
4. Mr. Michaux is working on a BMP list for the Development Office to give out to builders as part of the permitting process.
5. A purchase order has been written for equipment to monitor water quality at 7 sites along the Davis Canal. Mr. Michaux will do this initial monitoring.
6. The website domain oakislandcleanwater.org has been purchased and Mr. Zeid is working to migrate our information to this new site.
7. The Weather Channels program "After the Storm" has been purchased and formatted to be shown on Channel 8.

### **New Business**

Mr. Michaux will be attending the October 2<sup>nd</sup> DENR public meeting at the Coastline Convention Center in Wilmington to discuss phase 2 of the NPDES permit and invites other Board members to join him.
